Repeat Prescriptions

To allow our doctors and prescription clerks to process your request efficiently, we now require **4** working days to complete any prescription request. Completing a prescription is not an easy task. This involves the dispensary to carefully check your record and the GP doing the same and signing this off in between clinics.


Kindly note that it is your responsibility to ensure you have a sufficient supply of repeat medications. This is especially true during weekends and public holidays. Make sure that you check your medicine supply regularly. You can order your repeat prescription via email, NHS App, AiRMID UK or systmonline, or through your local pharmacy.
